APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Must be a permanent resident of the Buckeye Broadband service area (see eligible zip codes list below).
- 2. Must be pursuing a Career-Technical Education or trade program at an accredited post-secondary institution (must be a non-profit institution).
- 3. Must be a graduating high school senior.
- 4. Must have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA. Employees and dependents of employees of Buckeye Companies are not eligible to apply.
